Following are some key findings on the consequences of alcohol and drug use:

15.9% reported some form of public misconduct (such as trouble with police,

16.1% reported experiencing some kind of serious personal problems (such as suicidality,

Following are some key findings on opinions about the campus environment:

97.9% of students said the campus has alcohol and drug policies;

2.0% said they 'don't know'; and

0.1% said there wasn't a policy.

89.8% of students said the campus has an alcohol and drug prevention program;

10.0% said they 'don't know'; and

0.2% said there wasn't a program.

94.9% of students said the campus is concerned about the prevention of drug and alcohol use;

4.1% said they 'don't know'; and

1.0% said the campus is not concerned.

With regard to students' perceptions of other students' use:

63.3% of students believe the average student on campus uses alcohol once a week or more.

57.8% of students believe the average student on this campus uses some form of illegal drug at

For comparison purposes some figures are included from a reference group of 66199 students from 221 institutions who completed the Coe Alcohol and Drug Survey Long Form in 2016 to 2018 National Data
