Kahlert Foundation Scholarship for Computer and Mathematical Sciences (Current Students)

Purpose

The Kahlert Foundation Scholarship for Towson UTeach supports the academic achievement of current Towson University students who are pursuing dual teaching certification in computer science and mathematics at the secondary school level (grades 7-12).

Award

The total potential award amount is \$7,500. After a \$2,500 award in the initial year, the scholarship can be renewed (\$2,500) for up to two subsequent years provided the student is in good academic standing; has maintained a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.00; and has continued to successfully complete appropriate coursework toward the completion of the Computer and Mathematical Sciences Secondary Education major.

Eligibility

Student must

- be a Maryland resident
- have completed at least 15 college credits at Towson University or a Maryland Community College at the time the award is made. [TU freshmen may apply]
- have a combined grade point average from current and previous institutions of higher education of at least 3.00
- matriculate to Towson University (TU)
 enroll and maintain status as a full-time TU student (at least 12 credits)
