## APPEAL PROCEDURES

When students disagree with a grade they earned in a course or with an allegation of academic dishonesty, they have a right to appeal. This document outlines the appeal proizethere Towson University Honors College

1. If a student is dissatisfied with a grade, s/he mustriese t with the professor. Some in the Studen Integrity Policy (

- 2. If the student is dissatisfied with the explanation provided by the professor, s/he must write a letter of appeato the professor expressing specific concerns. The professor must respond to the student in writimggarding he/his decision and copy the Faculty Director. For allegations of academic dishonesty, if the student is dissatisfied with the professor's decision, s/he must appear writing to the professor within five working days
- 3. If the student is dissatisfied with the professor's response, s/he must write to letter Faculty Directorattaching a copy of the profess's written response. The Faculty Director will review the appeal. S/he may ask to meet with the student if further clarification is needed. The Faculty Directorust inform the student in writing her/his decision and opy the professor. (If the Faculty Directorust of academic dishonesty, the studentmust write a letter to the Faculty Directorust meet with the student and any additional information. The Faculty Directorust meet with the student with the student within five working days excepting holidays and University closings
- 4. If the student is dissatisfied with the Faculty Directoresponse, s/he mayrite a letter of appeal to the Honors College Dean (Dr. Terry CoorCorports of allprior correspondence from the professor and Faculty Directorest be attachedFor allegations of academic dishonesty, the student must submitterlef appeal to the Dean within five working daysof the receipt of the Faculty Director letter, excepting holidays and University closings
- 5. The Dean willreview the appeal and may ask to meet with the student if further information is required. The Deavill inform the student in writing f the decision

regarding the appeal and copy the Faculty Directod the professor. For allegations of academic dishonesty, the Dean will review the appeal and respond in writingin five working days excepting holidays and University closings, and copy the Faculty Director and professor.

6. If the student is dissatisfied with the decision of the Dean, s/he may appeal the decision by submitting a letter to the Student Appeals Committing conduct & Civility Education. For allegations of academic dishonesty, the student must submit a
